2026 EUROPEAN TOUR

Old World Baseball, LLC (OWB) is dedicated to providing high-quality, baseball-playing/cultural opportunities in Europe for groups and individuals. OWB's prior European Tours received rave reviews, and registration is underway for OWB's 2026 European Tour. 2026 Tour Travel Timing: Expected to be July 6-16, 2026. Exact travel dates will be finalized in late 2025.

2026 Tour Destinations: Destinations will be finalized in late 2025, with visits to at least three European countries, including France.

2026 Tour Game Schedule: 7-8 scheduled games against European national teams and/or high-level domestic clubs.

2026 Tour Prices: "Early Bird" Price (registration & payment received by December 31, 2025) = \$6,295, plus cost of flights to/from Europe; Price after December 31, 2025 = \$6,795, plus cost of flights to/from Europe. Trip price will include all basic intra-European travel expenses (i.e., ground transport, lodging and meals) and all cultural and competition-related expenses. Trip costs do not include flights to/from Europe or to/from our U.S. meeting point (if applicable).

OWB's 2026 European Tour is best suited for highly-motivated, mature and intellectually curious rising HS seniors and rising college freshmen. First-class coaching will be provided, with an emphasis on preparation for college baseball. Each player will be treated as a "whole" person and taught (or reminded of) the skills and strategies needed for a successful on and off-field transition from the high school to the college level.

OWB's 2026 European Tour will not have less than a 6:1 player/staff ratio. Staff members are again expected to include OWB co-founders Tom Gillespie and Stephan Rapaglia (resumés available at www.oldworldbaseball.com), as well as Justin Cronk (Founder of Diamond College Advisory Team and former Head Coach at Shenandoah University) and Stan Exeter (former Head Coach, Swarthmore College and Ursinus College).
